




RULES FOR VISITING THE MUSEUM

- Entry to the Museum requires a ticket. The purchase of a ticket constitutes the acceptance of all the Museum rules.
- Visitors are required to behave correctly during their visit, and must at all times respect the instructions of Fundación César Manrique (FCM) personnel.
- Touching or causing damage to the works of art on display is not permitted. They are fragile and may be easily damaged.
- It is not permitted to cross the security rope barriers or enter restricted areas within the Museum.
- Diving into the pool is not permitted.
- For safety reasons, visitors are not permitted to enter the Museum with sharp objects, large bags or backpacks (maximum 35 x 35cm), suitcases, scooters, bicycles, roller skates or motorbike helmets. There is no cloakroom at the FCM.
- The Museum takes no responsibility for objects that are left or lost within the facilities.
- Taking photos without flash is permitted, as well as videos recorded in domestic format in the exhibition rooms without disrupting the normal course of the tour. The use of tripods and selfie sticks is not permitted inside.
- Permission to carry out professional reportage photography or filming must be requested and authorised in advance.
- Mobile telephones and any other devices that emit sound must be on silent mode, and any talking should be at a reasonable and respectful volume throughout the visit.
- You may not enter the Museum with animals, except for guide or assistance dogs or other small animals kept in specific bags during the entire visit.
- Visitors are not permitted to enter barefoot, or with any footwear that might damage the Museum, or in swimwear, naked, stripped to the waist or, in general, in any clothing deemed unsuitable to the Foundation.
-  Eating and drinking within the exhibition rooms is not permitted.

- On specific occasions, Museum staff may restrict access to certain rooms due to visitor volume or to operational activities related to the setting up of exhibitions, the preservation of artworks or the maintenance of the facilities.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult. Adults must keep children by their side, stopping them from touching the works of art or running through the galleries.
- Inside the Museum, children under seven must be either held by the hand or carried by an adult.
- Visitors must behave in a civil and respectful manner in accordance with the rules of social harmony.
- Any person who fails to comply with any of the aforementioned points, along with anyone who disrupts the smooth running of the visit, may be ejected from the Museum without the price of their entry ticket being refunded.
- In the César Manrique House-Museum in Haría, due to the particular characteristics of the house, visitors may not enter with large or motorised wheelchairs. Wheelchairs suitable for carrying out visits are available from the ticket office.
